1. Holding of Pilik Choudhury Memorial Inter District School Football Tournament U-14 yrs. Boys

The district champion school team participates in Pilik Choudhury Memorial Inter District School Football Tournament U-14 yrs. Boys and the champion team of the tournament participates in the Subroto Mukherjee Cup Football Tournament organized by Subroto Mukerjee Sports Education Society every year at New Delhi.

2. Holding of Dewkon Memorial Inter District School Football Tournament U-17 yrs. Boys

The district champion school team participates in Dewkon Memorial Inter District School Football Tournament U-17 yrs. Boys and the champion team of the tournament participates in the Subroto Mukherjee Cup Football Tournament organized by Subroto Mukerjee Sports Education Society every year at New Delhi.

3. Holding of Nripendra Narayan Singha Inter District School Football Tournament U-17 yrs. Girls

The district champion school team participates in Nripendra Narayan Singha Inter District School Football Tournament U-17 yrs. Girls and the champion team of the tournament participates in the Subroto Mukherjee Cup Football Tournament organized by Subroto Mukerjee Sports Education Society every year at New Delhi.

10. Preparation and participation of Assam State Team in Subroto Mukherjee Cup Football Tournament (U-14 & 17 yrs. Boys and U-17 yrs. Girls)

The Champion School Teams of Pilik Choudhury (U-14 Boys), Dewkon Memorial (U-17 yrs. boys) and Nripendra Narayan Singha (U-17 yrs. Girls) teams participate in the said tournament.

11. Preparation and participation of Assam State Team in Jawaharlal Nehru Cup Hockey Tournament (U-17 yrs. Boys & Girls)

The Champion School Teams of Inter District School Hockey Tournament participate in the said tournament organized by Jawaharlal Nehru Hockey Tournament Society at New Delhi.

12. Holding of National School Games in the allotted sports disciplines by School Games Federation of India (SGFI)

The School Games Federation of India (SGFI) allots the responsibilities for holding of one or more tournaments to its Affiliated Units, and accordingly, the State organizes the tournament.

During 2019-20, the Directorate had organized the 65th National School Games in the discipline of Taekwondo U-19 Boys & Girls in Bhogeswari Phukanani Indoor Stadium, Guwahati w.e.f. 2nd to 6th November, 2019, wherein more than 800 players and officials from 32 affiliated States / Units under School Games Federation of India had participated. Players of Assam had won 8 Gold, 7 Silver and 1 Bronze Medals. The Assam Teams were emerged as “Best Team” in both categories.

13. Holding of Selection Trial and Coaching Camps in various disciplines and participation in tournaments organized by School Games Federation of India (SGFI) in various places of the country.

The selection trial and coaching camps are being organized for Assam State School Teams in different sports disciplines under different age groups for participation in National School Games, organized by the School Games Federation of India in different places of the country.

The Assam State School Teams of different sports disciplines under different age groups participated in 65th National School Games, organized by the School Games Federation during 2019-20. Assam had secured 23 Gold, 37 Silver and 77 Bronze medals, being the grand total of 137 medals.

14. Holding of State Level Coaching Camp in Olympic disciplines by engaging Departmental Coaches in the disciplines of Archery, Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Boxing, Football, Gymnastics, Hockey, Judo, Kabaddi, Kho Kho, Shooting, Swimming, Table Tennis, Lawn Tennis, Volleyball, Weightlifting, Wrestling for both Boys & Girls.

15. Holding of Residential Coaching Camp for Front Ranking Players of the State by the Coaches of National repute to enhance performance of State players in National and International events in the disciplines of Boxing, Archery, Athletics, Weightlifting, Taekwondo and Volleyball.

16. Holding of Mukhya Monrir Gaon Panchayat Paryayar Krida Protiyogita in the disciplines of Athletics & Football U – 17 & 19 yrs. both Boys & Girls

Mukhya Monrir Gaon Panchayat Paryayar Krida Protiyogita in the Sports disciplines of Football and Athletics was organized successfully at Block, District and State levels.

17. Preparation and participation of Assam State Team in Khelo India Youth Games.

Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India, has been organizing Khelo India Youth Games in various sports disciplines since 2018, in which talented players from all the States / UTs of the country take part. To have better results and to bring laurels for the State, Assam team is prepared through coaching.

18. Holding of State Divyangjan Sports Meets as per Paralympics norms.

In order to make sports all inclusive, the Department has successfully conducted the State Level Divyangjan Sports Meet (Special and Paralympic) during 2019-20 in the disciplines of Football, Cricket, Badminton, Athletics and Swimming.

19. Holding of Mukhya Monrir Mohila Kriya Pratiyogita in the discipline of Athletics

To encourage the participation of women in sports and to identify and promote talent of the women of the State, the Department has successfully conducted a new scheme "Mukhya Monrir Mohila Kriya Pratiyogita, 2019" during the year 2019-20 in the sports discipline of Athletics. The scheme was implemented at District levels covering all 33 Districts and State level centrally in Guwahati.

20. Holding of State School Olympic at Block, District and State levels

To identify sporting talents at the initial age and to prepare talented players for better performance of the State in the National School Games, Khelo India Youth Games, a new scheme "State School Olympic, Block, District and State Level", in 7 (seven) Olympic disciplines viz: Archery, Badminton, Basketball, Gymnastics, Table Tennis, Judo and Weightlifting, the aforesaid scheme was successfully executed at Block, District and State levels during the year 2019-20.

21. Holding of Adventure Sports like – Mountaineering, Trekking, Rock Climbing, Water Rafting etc. for popularizing the adventure sports in the State. The programmes were implemented during 2019-20 at Morigaon, Baksa, Bongaigaon and Sikkim.

22. Preparation and participation of North East Youth Festival & National Youth Festival

23. Supply of Sports Goods under regular scheme.

Under the scheme, sports goods like Football, Football Goal Net, Volleyball, Volleyball Net, Carom Board, Badminton Rackets and Shuttles, etc. are provided to Hon'ble MLAs, Registered Sports Clubs, Youth Clubs, Associations, Educational Institutions, etc. on receipt of applications and depending upon availability of fund.

24. Distribution of Sports Goods to 126 MLAs under regular scheme.

Sports goods like Football, Football Goal Net, Volleyball and Volleyball Net are distributed to all the Hon'ble MLAs of the state for providing the Sports Goods to 10 (ten) active registered Clubs of their respective constituencies under the scheme.

25. Chief Minister Samagra Gramya Unnayan Yojana (Assam Youth Development Mission Society)

Sports & Youth Welfare Department, Govt. of Assam, has taken up the scheme of “Development of 500 Playfields” in the entire State through Assam Youth Development Mission Society under the Mega Mission Society – Chief Minister Samagra Gramya Unnayan Yojana” (MMS - CMSGUY).

Accordingly, in the 1st phase, a total number of 369 playfields has been identified for development, and on 18th January, 2018, the Hon’ble Chief Minister of Assam and Chairman, Governing Body of Assam Youth Development Mission Society had launched this mega scheme, at Srimanta Sakardev Kalakshetra. Subsequently 79 out of 131 playfields had been shortlisted for development on obtaining approval from the Hon’ble CM in the 2nd meeting of Governing Body of AYDMS, held on 1st July, 2019. The process for selection of developing 52 playfields has already been initiated.
