idea about running of the academies and meeting that desired goal i.e. high performance of the players. He also emphasize on running the academy smoothly by providing all facilities to the trainees.

Sri Barun Mandal, Pinku Basumatary and Smti. Kabita Changmai gave a brief report of the academies stating that the academy is running smoothly in regard to training, schooling, medical facilities and hostel facility.

Sri Barun Mandal informed that at times it becomes difficult to get fooding from Lakhimi Catering. He requested to have an understanding with Lakhimi Catering, so that the mess runs smoothly with good quality food.

The Committee resolved to have a written agreement with management of the Lakhimi Catering to run the mess on behalf of the Society as directed.

The Society decided that Lakhimi Catering an experienced party which have been providing quality food to the trainees for last two years and to continue with the same quality food.

The Society will release fund to the caterer as per bill on receipt of fund from the Govt.

The Warden informed that all fans in the hostel are not functioning and out of order. The Committee decided to purchase 34 nos. of Polar Fans after inspection.

Two Freezes are to be replaced and Sri Barun Mandal was entrusted to do the work at the earliest and submit bills for payment.

Wash Basin in the dinning hall needs repairing. Sri Barun Mandal is to do the works and submit bills.

The hostel Warden Smti. Kabita Changmai informed that the students comes from the school at different times, to provide them hot food, 3 big hot cases are required. The Committee agreed to her suggestion and decided to purchase hot case at market price.

The Committee decided to provide playing dress and equipments twice a year or as per need and report of the concerned coaches. The Committee will verify the needs and urgency for consideration.

The wardens, Sri Pinku Basumatari and Smti. Kabita Changmai will take responsibility for academic affairs of the trainees including visiting schools as guardian and provide travel expenses and pocket money etc. from time to time

The President finally expressed the vote of thanks to all the members present and declared the proceeding of the meeting of the academies closed.
